


This Sunday, November 01, is “All Saints Day” and is meant for us mortals to honor those that have moved into the presence of our Lord. The Book of Revelations describes the 144,000 saints (Jews) receiving God’s seal on their foreheads (Chapter 7: 4-8). Then verses 9-17 reveal our Lord’s interaction with the “great multitudes” that no one could count!! We are part of that great multitude. Think about it. The Book of Revelations is already showing what things will look like for us!! Wow!!

The Apostle Paul’s letter to the Thessalonians (1 and 2) is about hope, joy, being imitators of Christ Jesus, being called to a state of sanctification, and loving one another. First Thessalonians 4: 13-18 recalls those saints who have “fallen asleep” in the Lord. Paul says about the saints – to not grieve as do the rest (other people) who have no hope (vs 13). Don’t be afraid about the affects of covid-19 or any other disaster or calamity that can or might strike us. Our Lord has more than proven to us that He is in full control of all things and we do not need to fear.

Here’s the bottom line – “For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep, we will live together with him” (1 Thess 5: 9-10).

AUTHORS AND PARENTS ARE RETHINKING WAYS TO FOSTER KIDS' LOVE FOR SCRIPTURE—CORRIE CUTRER



A Christian parent's greatest hope is echoed in 3 John: "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth" (v. 4). Throughout each generation, mothers and fathers have looked for ways to point their children to the Bible as the ultimate source of truth, wisdom, and spiritual transformation. Adults may recall how, in their formative years, they were taught to recite the books of the Bible, learn characters and plotlines of important stories, or memorize key verses, with an emphasis on the godly thinking and behav-

iors that develop as a result.

While a focus on Bible knowledge and upright living remains essential, several emerging authors are taking a fresh look at how contemporary parents can introduce children to Scripture in ways that cultivate an authentic relationship with God and a committed affection for his Word. Their approach prioritizes the role the Bible can play in children's spiritual formation, helping kids connect God's Word with their own deepest longings. They emphasize viewing all of Scripture as a connected text that shines a light on our need for Christ. And they believe that teaching kids to treasure Scripture begins with moms and dads nurturing their own spiritual lives.

Paul tells the now believers in verse 8 “Having so fond an affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us.”

Each one of you are very dear to me and the rest of the community. Those in your church family are very dear as well.

Although Paul was speaking to believers in Thessalonica, chapter 2 can be seen as a template for us as disciples as well. We are to share our lives, lovingly, with others. This holds true for both believers and non-believers. It is really about relationships.

I challenge myself and well as you to focus on relationships during this time of unrest for so many. To serve and encourage others by sharing your experiences with them.
